SILURIANS AWARD

Presented by the Society of the Silurians, the organization of veteran editors and reporters, for investigative reporting. 1978, 1990, 1994, 1995, 1996, 1998, 2003, 2006, 2007, 2009, 2011, 2013.

GEORGE POLK AWARD

ARTnews has had the rare honor of receiving the Polk – one of the most coveted awards in American journalism – twice, including one for “a remarkable East-West journalistic achievement.” 1981, 1992.

COMMITTEE FOR JEWISH CLAIMS ON AUSTRIA AWARD

For a series of articles and editorials that prompted Austria to transfer thousands of long-hidden art objects stolen by the Nazis from victims of the Holocaust to the Jewish Community of Vienna. 1996.

OVERSEAS PRESS CLUB OF AMERICA CITATION OF EXCELLENCE

This annual honor was presented to ARTnews for groundbreaking investigative reporting in the former Soviet Union. 1992.

PAGE ONE AWARD

Presented by the Newspaper Guild of New York for a “brilliant job of investigating and reporting.” 1985.

CLARION AWARD

Presented by Women in Communications. One of the citations as for “excellence, creativity, believability, and effectiveness.” 1981, 1984, 1998, 2000 (twice).

NATIONAL MAGAZINE AWARD FOR GENERAL EXCELLENCE

Presented by the American Society of Magazine Editors and the Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism for “first class” reporting, analysis, criticism, and graphics. 1981.

NATIONAL HEADLINER AWARD

Presented for outstanding coverage of a news event by a magazine. 1985, 1994, 1998.

DEADLINE CLUB AWARD FOR EXCELLENCE IN JOURNALISM

Presented by a chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists for a series of articles on controversial sculpture casts said to have been made by Degas. 2011.

NATIONAL ARTS CLUB DISTINGUISHED CITATION OF MERIT

Presented for being “the nation’s preeminent source of recording the most exciting developments in the art world.” 1997.

NATIONAL MAGAZINE AWARD FOR PUBLIC INTEREST

Cited as a finalist by the Columbia University Graduate School of Journalism on behalf of the American Society of Magazine Editors, for a series of articles in the public interest category. 1986.

INVESTIGATIVE REPORTERS & EDITORS AWARD

Screened by faculty members of the University of Missouri School of Journalism and presented for outstanding investigative reporting. 1984.

SOCIETY OF PUBLICATION DESIGNERS AWARD

Presented for outstanding design and accompanied by a special citation for innovative photography. 1975.
